# Media & Learning delivery

TheWell combines open content access, media distribution and structured learning in one handy platform.

## Media Library and Collections

Useful for open browsing, public collections, and flexible content delivery.

## LMS and Moodle

Useful for guided learning, courses, learner enrolment, and organized progress.

## Learning App

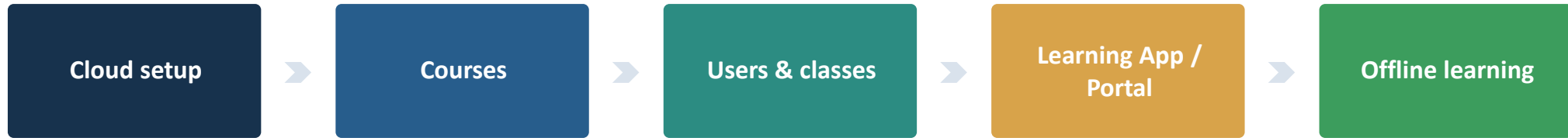
Useful for learner-facing access and a smoother repeat-use experience.

## Big picture

TheWell is strongest when content delivery and learning delivery are used together: collections support access, while the LMS supports progression and structure.

# Learning Model overview

A simple end-to-end view of learning delivery inside TheWell.



## Learning flow

Cloud Administrators prepare access and content, learners are added and enrolled, content becomes available through the app or portal, and learning continues in low-connectivity contexts.

# LMS & Moodle in TheWell Systems

TheWell learning delivery is built around a Moodle-based LMS.

- The LMS is part of the wider TheWell ecosystem alongside media collections and box delivery.
- Supports structured training, learner enrolment, course delivery, and progress tracking.
- This makes TheWell suitable for both open content access and more formal learning programs.

## What Moodle adds

- Course structure
- Learner enrolment
- Progress tracking
- Training organization
- Offline-first delivery model

## Best fit

Moodle-based LMS is most valuable when content must be delivered as a guided program, not only as a media library.

# LMS capabilities

| Capability          | Practical use                                                             |
|---------------------|---------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| User management     | Add learners / users, maintain and edit their learning access.            |
| Class management    | Create classes of learners for easier organization and training delivery. |
| Course enrolment    | Enrol individual users or whole classes into a course.                    |
| Learning access     | Use TheWell Portal and TheWell Learning App to reach course content.      |
| Progress visibility | Sync learning data back to the cloud when internet is available.          |
| Course management   | Upload, edit and restructure learning materials.                          |
| Structure           | Provides more scalable program delivery across organizations and sites.   |

# Learning App

The app gives learners a more direct and familiar way to access learning content.

- The app supports learner-focused access to enrolled content and training materials.
- A simpler learner interface and structure improve adoption, repeat use, and confidence for learners.
- The app helps make the learning experience easier to return to regularly.

The Learning App sits on the **user side** of the system: after users are added and enrolled, it becomes one of the main access points for learning.

# Learning App & Portal access

How learners move from access to active learning.

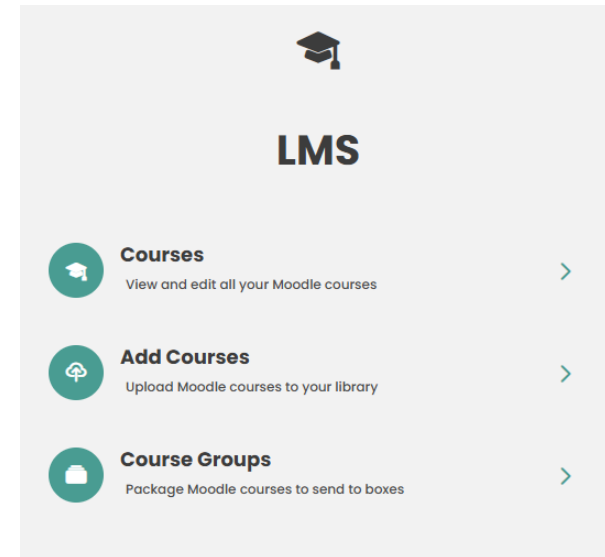
- 1 Connect to TheWell Box**  
Learners connect through the local box network using their own phone, tablet, or laptop.
- 2 Open the portal or app**  
Learners access content either through TheWell Portal or through TheWell Learning App.
- 3 Find assigned learning**  
The learner sees the relevant learning resources, courses, or collections prepared for them.
- 4 Continue learning offline**  
Learning continues locally even when full internet connectivity is not available.

# Getting started with LMS

Before uploading courses to a Moodle-based LMS you need to create backup in **.mbz** (Moodle) extension .

1. Access the [cloud](#).
2. Open  LMS menu >  Add Courses.
3. Select Course Language and press +.
4. Select **.mbz** backup file and 
5. Go to  Courses.  

6. Select Course and press edit  
7. Add thumbnail, display name and description. Save.
8. Group courses for further sending.



# Send Courses from Cloud to Boxes

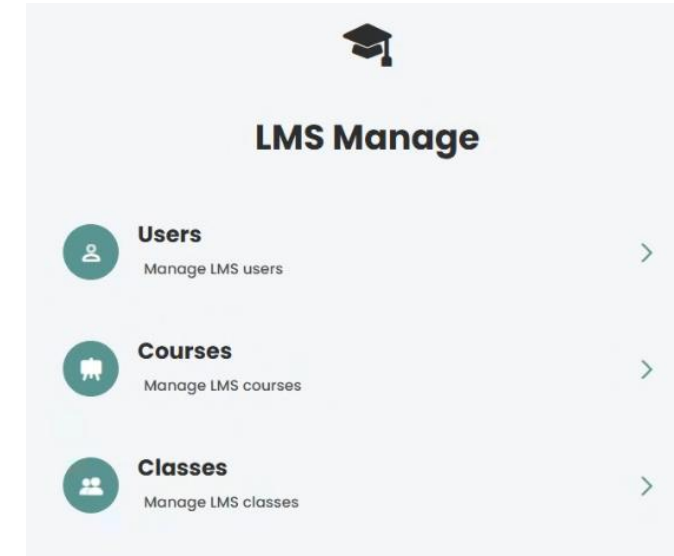
Manage course groups assigned to boxes.

1. Open  BOX menu >  Send Courses.
2. Select box by site & nickname. 
3. Go to 
4. Select group. 
5. Now group(s) are assigned and the box will sync when internet is available.

# User Management (BOX)

Create user accounts for learnens and teachers.

1. Access the admin section in [TheWell Portal](#).
2. Go to LMS Manage.
3. Open Users.
4. Create + New (there are three roles: student/teacher/editing teacher).
5. Fill in: first & last name, add email, create username & password.

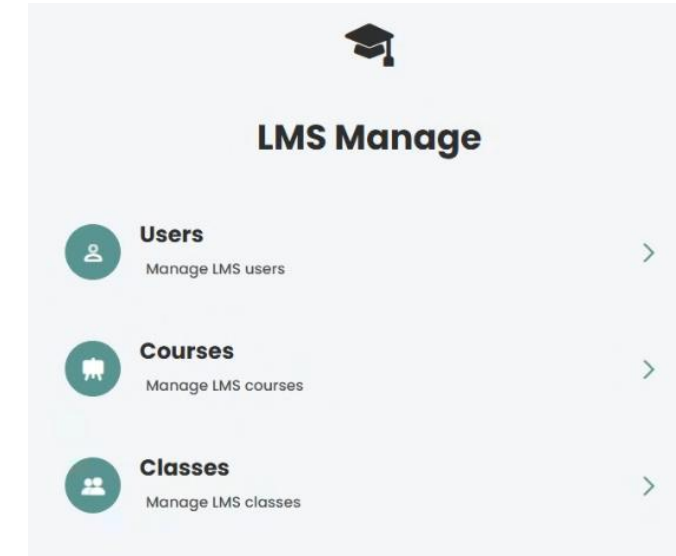

# Class Management (BOX)

Create classes with selected learnens (users)

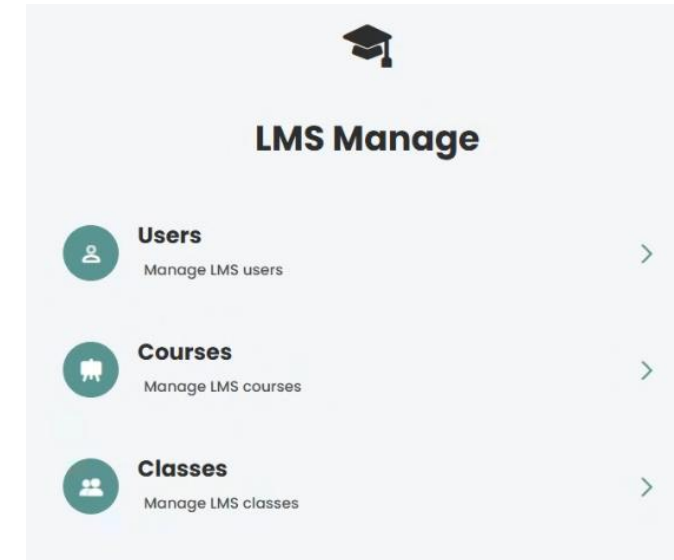
1. Go to LMS Manage.
2. Open Classes.
3. Create  and give it a name. Save.
4. Press edit.  
5. Add learners  (teachers are not added to the class list).



# Course Enrollments (BOX)

Enroll teachers, learners and classes to courses.

1. Go to LMS Manage.
2. Open Courses.
3. Find a course to enroll teachers and learners. Press edit.
4. Press **+ Add Student**
5. Find user and press add.
6. Select a role – student, teacher or editing teacher.
7. Add classes. **+ Add Class**

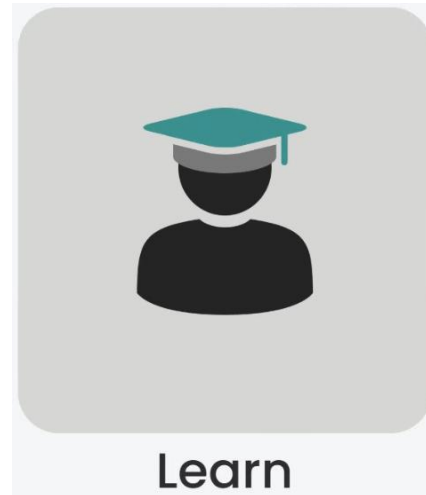

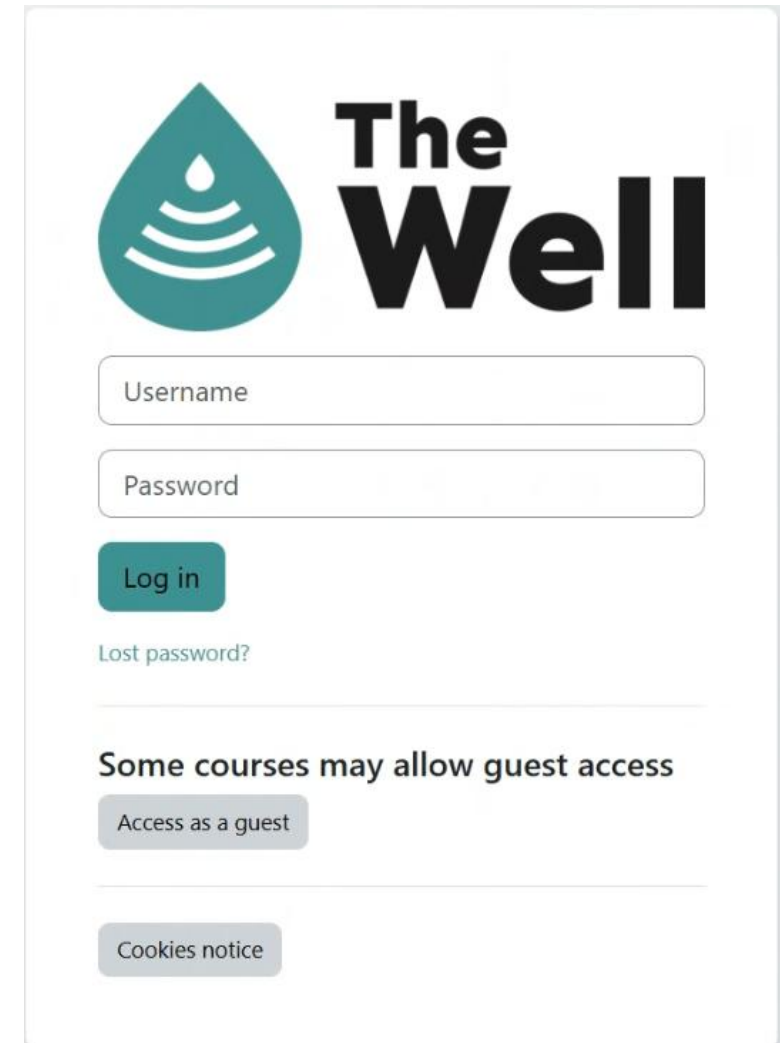
